

POLICY 2.16: TECHNOLOGY USE & ACCESS

Sandburg maintains access for its administrators, faculty, staff and students to local, national and international sources of information and provides an atmosphere that encourages access to knowledge and sharing of information via technology (e.g., the internet, laptops, etc.). These information resources are used by college personnel and students with respect for the public trust afforded the institution, in accordance with college regulations, and within local, state, and federal copyright and information laws.

To ensure continued availability of technology information resources and access to them by college personnel and students, the college — in concert with local, state and federal law and regulations — will take action against those who violate this policy or disrupt the function of these systems.
