

POLICY 3.15: ACADEMIC STANDING

Students are expected to make progress toward attaining an expressed educational objective. Sandburg measures this two ways:

Financial aid satisfactory academic progress

Students must demonstrate satisfactory academic progress to continue to receive financial aid at Sandburg. Their progress is evaluated at the end of each semester to determine their financial aid eligibility for the next semester. Students are evaluated based on grade point average (GPA), completion rate and maximum timeframe. Students receiving financial aid are required to meet satisfactory academic progress (SAP) standards according to federal and state regulations. Details of financial aid satisfactory academic progress are outlined in the college catalog.

Institutional academic standing

Students must meet the academic standing policy to continue their undergraduate enrollment at Sandburg. Their academic standing is reviewed at the end of each semester to determine their standing for the next semester. Academic standards include an evaluation of grade point average (GPA) and completion rate. Details of academic standards are outlined in the college catalog.

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
