The Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI) is a statewide transfer agreement that facilitates transfer among more than 100 participating institutions in Illinois. The IAI General Education Core Curriculum (GECC) includes the following categories and courses with credit hours in parentheses:

COMMUNICATION

- Three courses or (9)

HUMANITIES AND FINE ARTS

- Three courses total
 - One must be a Humanities course
 - One must be a Fine Arts course
 - The additional course is the student's choice or as directed by the advisor.

SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES

- Three courses or (9)
- Courses must be from three different subject areas.

MATHEMATICS

- One course (3-5)

PHYSICAL SCIENCE AND LIFE SCIENCES

- Two courses total
 - One from each area (7-8)
 - One must have a lab.

HUMAN RELATIONS

- One course or (3)
