1+1 pathway

The 1 + 1 program allows you to enroll in college courses at a little slower pace to accommodate your high school commitments. You'll take the first year of classes toward your associate in arts (AA) degree. After graduation from high school, you'll enroll at Sandburg to complete the rest of your degree requirements. This option still enables you to save money because you could complete a bachelor's degree in three years instead of four.
