INSTRUCTIONS/NOTES FOR EACH SECTION

- A. Points based on your valid ACT, SAT, or TEAS score. *** Note: TEAS scores are valid for 2 years, SAT and ACT scores are valid for 5 years.**
- B. Points based on previous college-level coursework and college degree.
- C. Students must obtain a verification form from their advisor and complete at least 2 hours of observation/job showing with a licensed dental hygienist. The verification form must be returned directly to the advisor from the dental office for the student to be awarded points.
- D. BIO 101 and CHM 100 are prerequisite classes for BIO 200, BIO 211, and BIO 212.
- E. The point value you select should be based on your highest grade in the specified course. BIO 200, BIO 211, and BIO 212 are Carl Sandburg College course numbers. See the Carl Sandburg College Course Catalog for course descriptions. **** All Science courses must not have been taken more than seven (7) years before the time of application (BIO.200, BIO.211, and BIO.212)***
- F. A copy of your license or employer documentation must accompany your application.
- G. This is where you total the points earned in sections A-F (Note the maximum allowed for each section).

A minimum of 23 points is required.

- **Required vaccinations:** measles, mumps, rubella, chicken pox, 2-step TB, hepatitis B, and TDaP vaccines. Details for these required vaccinations are presented at the mandatory orientation meeting.
- Students must have evidence of satisfactory academic progress to be eligible for financial aid consideration for the program (if a student is suspended from Carl Sandburg, they are not eligible).
