- C. The point value you select should be based on your highest grade in the specified course. BIO 200, BIO 211, BIO 212, and MDT 100 are Carl Sandburg College course numbers. See the Carl Sandburg College Course Catalog for course descriptions. * ***All Science courses must not have been taken more than (7) years before the time of application (BIO.200, BIO.211, and BIO.212)***
- D. This is where you total up the points you have earned in sections A-C. (Note the maximum allowed for each section.)

A minimum of 4 points is required to be considered for the program.
