Total completion time: 10 months*

REGISTERED NURSE — RN (ASSOCIATE DEGREE)

Step 1:General education courses: Sociology 101, Philosophy 103 and Biology 200.

Step 2: English 101

Step 3: Psychology 101

Step 4: Biology 211 & 212 (prerequisites: Biology 101 & Chemistry 100)

Step 5: Completion of basic nursing assistant training 101 within one year or active on the registry.

Total completion time: Two years*

CNA

- Reposition bedridden patients.
- Answer patient calls to determine patients' needs.
- Help patients eat or drink.
- Measure and record food and liquid intake.
- Help patients perform daily living activities, such as getting out of bed, bathing, dressing, using the toilet, standing, walking or exercising.

LPN

- Observe patients, charting and reporting changes in patients' conditions & take any necessary action.
- Measure & record patients' vital signs.
- Administer prescribed medications.
- Provide basic patient care or treatments.
- Answer patients' calls, and determine how to assist them.

RN

- Record medical info & vital signs.
- Administer meds & monitor for reactions/side effects.
- Maintain accurate, detailed reports/records.
- Monitor, record & report symptoms or changes.
- Provide healthcare, first aid, immunizations in schools, hospitals or industry.
