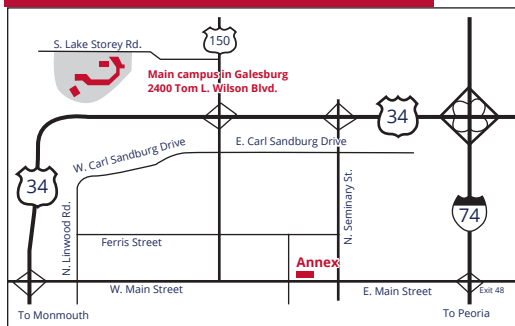

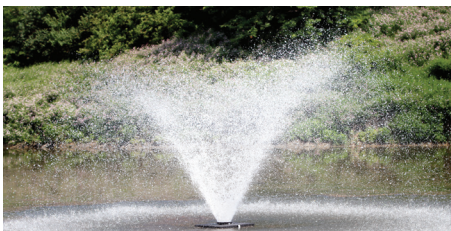

DIRECTIONS TO GALESBURG CAMPUS FROM I-74

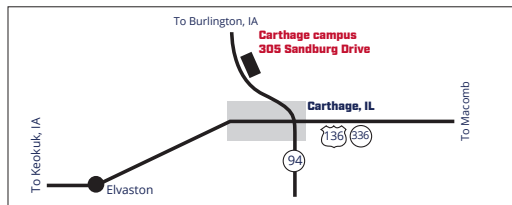
- I-74 West to Hwy. 34

The Carthage campus is located on the north edge of Carthage, just off state Highway 94. It also serves seven unit

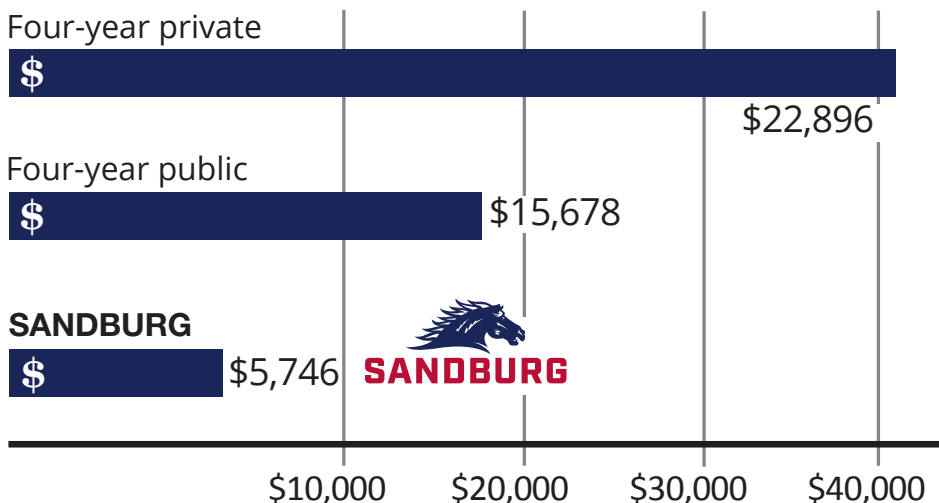

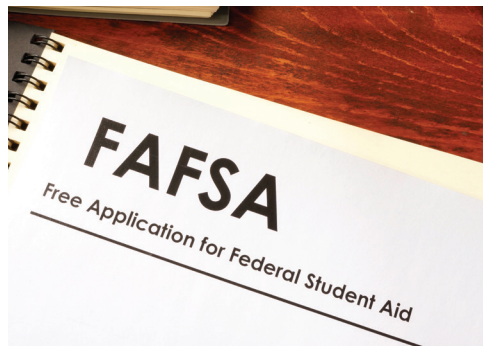
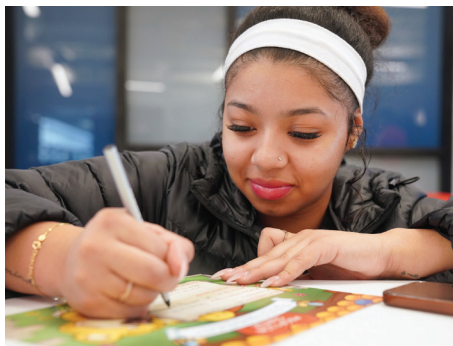
Illinois tuition & fee comparison*

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Sandburg Foundation awards more than \$500,000 in scholarships each year to Sandburg students.

Scholarship applications for the following academic year are open Oct. 1-June 15. Priority deadline is March 15, and the final deadline is June 15. Learn more at sandburg.edu/scholarships. Below is a small sampling of scholarships available to students.

DUAL-CREDIT SUCCESS

A one-time, \$1,500 scholarship available to students who successfully completed at least six hours of dual credit with Sandburg during high school.

PROMISE PROGRAMS

Students from select high schools can have up to 100% of tuition covered through two promise programs: Galesburg Promise for Galesburg High School and Galesburg Christian School graduates, and Sampson Promise for Monmouth-Roseville and United high schools, as well as home-schooled students in the districts. Applications for the following academic year for each promise program are open between Oct. 1-June 15.

PRESIDENTIAL

This full-tuition scholarship, based on your SAT/ACT scores and high school GPAs, is limited to a select number of graduates from high schools within Sandburg's district.

TALENT

Available to students with exceptional talents in academic achievement, creative writing, music, journalism, theater, art or athletics. Waives tuition for up to 18 credit hours per semester.

Our advising staff and general education curriculum helps make your transition to a four-year institution as simple as possible, and we have 25 university transfer programs in place to give you a clear roadmap to your next destination.

HOW TO APPLY

Step 1: Submit your application.

- Complete our free online application.
- Check your email in one to two business days for your acceptance letter.
- Monitor your admissions application portal and email for updates.

Step 2: Provide your course placement information.

To help determine the best starting point for your coursework, you can submit one or more of the following documents. A high school or college transcript is recommended but not required for admission to Sandburg.

- Request your official high school/college transcripts from all the institutions you've attended or your high school equivalency exam results (GED/HiSet). Documents can be sent through Parchment or emailed to transcripts@sandburg.edu. High school transcript or equivalency exam results are required for financial aid.
- Send official ACT/SAT scores directly from the testing agency (ACT or College Board) if you have taken one of these tests within the past five years.
- Check the admissions application portal to see if you need to take the Accuplacer placement test.
- For additional information on Accuplacer testing, visit the testing center.

Step 3: Apply for financial aid.

- Complete the free application for federal student aid (FAFSA) application to be considered for federal, state and/or school financial aid programs (e.g., grants, scholarships, work-study funds, loans). Sandburg's federal school code: 007265. Complete the remaining financial aid steps and visit financial aid.

Step 4: Register for your classes.

Step 5: Pay your tuition.

- Several payment options are available, including payment plans.
